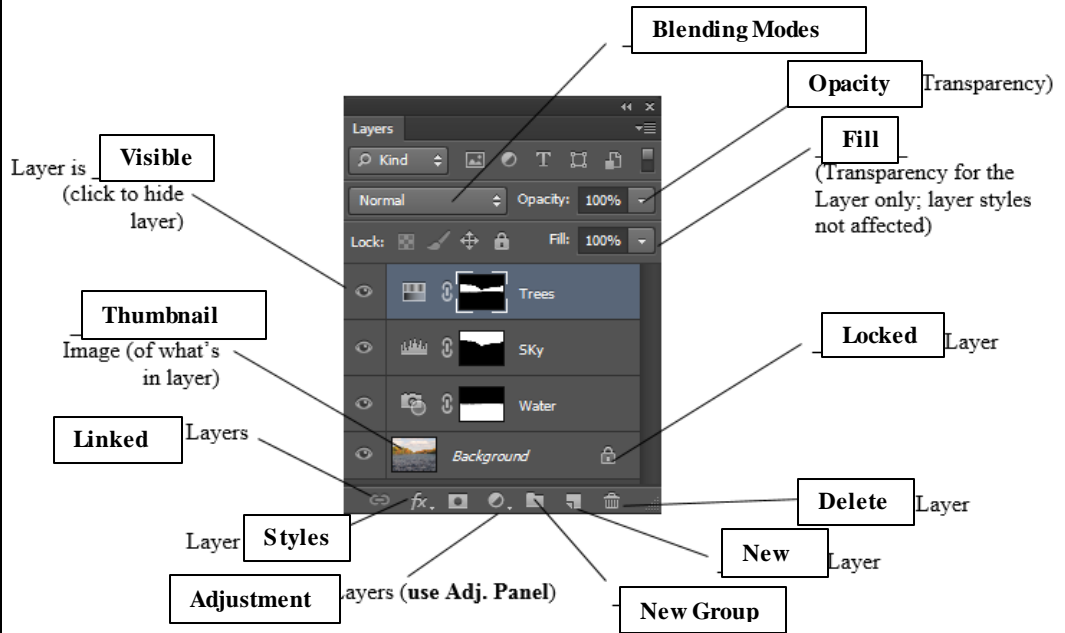

Overview of the Layers Panel



Layer Basics

1. Unlocking the Background Layer → **Double click mouse on layer; rename**
2. Always **name** your layers (double click the layer to rename)
3. Thumbnails (can be resized going to Layer Panel Menu; choose Panel Options)
4. **Rearrange Layers** → click and drag layer to desired location in Layers Panel
5. Opacity v. Fill (see explanation above in Layers Panel Illustration); important to know the difference!
6. Resize/Rotate Layers → use **Transform** Tools (Edit > Transform OR use Free Transform OR CONTROL + T)
7. Adjustment Layers
 - a. **Nondestructive** layer changes
 - i. Allows user to go back and edit further in the future or remove the adjustment all together without destroying the image.
 - b. NEVER use **Image** > **Adjustments** commands (does not turn into an Adj. Layer)
