



	<p><b>Filters</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You can use filters to add <b>Special Effects</b> to your Photoshop layers.</li> <li>Filters appears in the <b>Filters</b> menu in the application bar.</li> <li>Filters can be applied to an <b>Entire, Open</b> layer while others can be applied to a certain <b>Selection (masks)</b></li> <li>Some filters only work with <b>RGB</b> images.</li> <li>Changing a layer to a <b>SmartFilter</b> allows you to work with the filters non-destructively for that layer. 	c. Must <b><u>Select</u></b> the text before warping.
	4. Use the <b><u>Paragraph</u></b> Panel to change
	the alignment of the text or to
	hyphenate/not hyphenate text in a

	5. Use this keyboard shortcut to change the
	size of your font: <b><u>SHIFT + CONTROL + &lt;&gt; keys</u></b>
