Row 2 Connection to Knowledge of the Internet	PARAGRAPH 1	Appropriately connects knowledge of the Internet to the area of focus.	Do NOT award a point if any one of the following is true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● the focus of area on the broader issue is not stated ● no explanation of the focus of area connecting to concepts of the Internet 		
Row 3 Positive & Negative Impact to Society	PARAGRAPHS 2 AND 3	Adequately presents beneficial/positive impacts, as well as the harmful/negative impacts.	Do NOT award a point if any one of the following is true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● the response is missing the adjectives harmful or beneficial (or synonyms thereof) ● the response is missing a plausible beneficial effect ● the response is missing a plausible harmful effect 		
Row 4 Position on the Issue	PARAGRAPH 4	States a position on the issue AND Makes a convincing argument supported by facts/details.	Do NOT award a point if any one of the following is true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● a position is not stated on the issue ● arguments are not supported by facts and/or details ● arguments are supported by personal opinions 		
Row 5 Finding and Evaluating Information	REFERENCES	References, through in-text citation, at least 3 different sources.	In-text citations exist in the reflection. Do NOT award a point if any one of the following is true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● the response contains a list of sources only, no in-text citations; ● the response contains less than three in-text citations; or ● there are fewer than three sources cited, even if there are three or more in-text citations
